Looking for a **SECURE** method of destroying your old, outdated personal files? **The Natrona County Sheriff Cadets** have teamed up with **Powder River Shredders, LLC, Pepsi and Wal-Mart** to raise funds for the Cadet Program on Saturday, **May 18, 2019 from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.**

Clean out your old bank statements, pay stubs, tax records, household bills, medical bills, credit card bills, cancelled checks, legal papers and more...

Box them up and bring them to the **West Side Wal-Mart** parking lot, 4255 CY Ave in Casper, where **Powder River Shredders, LLC.** will be on site. Law Enforcement Officers will be on scene to assist you with your documents. Please try to limit your paperwork to 100 pounds per customer. Also, through the **Casper – Natrona County Health Department**, will be accepting old or unused prescriptions and over-the-counter medications for destruction. If you have any old or unused prescriptions and over-the-counter medications that need destroyed, please bring them along.
