2020 CRIMSON DAWN MIDSUMMER'S EVE CANCELLED DUE TO COVID-19 CONCERNS

Crimson Dawn Association has made the difficult decision to cancel the 2020 Crimson Dawn Midsummer's Eve event due to COVID-19 concerns.

The annual Midsummer's Eve event hosts over 700 visitors every year. The event cannot accommodate appropriate social distancing and safety measures for our guests in such large numbers. The Crimson Dawn Association believes that holding our beloved event is not worth the risk of even one person becoming seriously ill or losing their life.

Crimson Dawn Park and Museum will be closed on June 21, 2020.

En lieu of Midsummer's Eve, Crimson Dawn Association is working on providing the public with a remote celebration. More details to come.

Crimson Dawn Park will be open to the public June 15 - September 15, 2020, with the exception of Sunday June 21<sup>st</sup>. Crimson Dawn Museum will be open on weekends and access to the museum will be limited to 4 guests at time.
