

SHRUBS

*** **4-WING SALT BUSH** - Mature height 4'. Native, excellent salt and alkali tolerance. Good wildlife forage value.

*** (F) **ANTELOPE BITTERBRUSH** - Mature height 6'. Native, excellent drought tolerance and cold hardiness. Well suited for a wide range of soils. Excellent wildlife food source.

*** **CARAGANA** - Mature height 10'. Excellent drought, cold and alkali tolerances. Very hardy, good choice for windbreaks. Multi stemmed best in sandy to loamy soils up to 9,500'.

* (F) **CHOKECHERRY** - Mature height 10'. Excellent cold hardiness. Good choice for windbreaks and attracting wildlife. Native, up to 9,000'.

* **COTONEASTER** - Medium shrub; drought resistant; alkaline tolerant; high wildlife value.

* **FALSE INDIGO** - Mature height up to 10'. Native shrub. Tolerant of wind, drought, soil pH and moisture variations.

*** **GAMBEL OAK** - Large shrub. Mature height of 15'. Native. Excellent drought tolerance. Good cover for small wildlife and acorns provide wildlife food source.

* (F) **GOLDEN CURRANT** - Native, small to medium shrub, fairly drought and alkali tolerant. Good cover for small wildlife. Plant up to 8,000'.

* (F) **LILAC** - Mature height 10'. Dense shrub, excellent cold hardiness and windbreak suitability. Attractive purple flowers. Multi stemmed, grows well in most soils up to 8,000'.

*** (F) **MOUNTAIN MAHOGANY** - Mature height 6'. Excellent cold hardiness and grows well up to 9000'

* **NANKING CHERRY** - Mature height 6'. Excellent cold hardiness and wildlife suitability. Grows well in most soils up to 8,000'.

* (F) **NATIVE PLUM** - Mature height 8'. Excellent cold hardiness, windbreak and wildlife suitability. Does well in most soils (excluding strongly alkaline) statewide up to 8,000'.

*** **NEW MEXICO PRIVET** - Mature height 10'. Multi stemmed. Excellent for windbreaks, cold hardiness, alkali tolerance & wildlife suitability up to 7,500'.

◆ **RED-OSIER DOGWOOD** - Mature height 10'. Native. Great winter color. Excellent wildlife suitability, fast growing, multi-stemmed shrub.

* (F) **SASKATOON SERVICEBERRY** - Mature height 3'. Native with edible fruit and showy flowers. Cold hardy, moderate growth, attracts big game, drought resistance is fair, moist soils. Up to 9,000 ft.

*(F) **SHRUBBY CINQUEFOIL** - Mature height up to 3-4 1/2'. Exfoliating or shredding bark on older stems. Attracts butterflies; tolerant of rabbits, deer, drought, erosion, and clay soils. Prefers evenly moist soil and full sun to part shade. Avoid poorly drained wet soils. Fire wise low flammability.

***SILVER BUFFALOBERRY** - Mature height 10'. Suckering shrub; withstands cold, wind and drought; tolerates alkaline soils, attracts birds. Native, Indians used the berries to flavor buffalo meat.

*** **THREE LEAF SUMAC** - Small to medium shrub, excellent drought resistance, alkali tolerant, plant to 8,000'.

WAX CURRENT - Native, mature height 3'. Does not perform well in salty soil. High wildlife value, grows 5,000 to 11,500'

DESCRIPTIONS

SHRUBS *continued*

* **WILD ROSE / WOODS ROSE** - Mature height 4'. Rapid growth, excellent wildlife value, especially in winter, up to 10,000'.

DECIDUOUS TREES

◆ (F) **ASPEN** - Mature height 35'. Attractive ornamental tree. Prefers moist soils. Excellent cold hardiness. Potential disease problems

*** **BUR OAK** - Mature height 40'. Excellent drought tolerance, windbreak and wildlife suitability up to 6,500'. Slow to establish.

*** **HACKBERRY** - Mature height 40'. Excellent cold hardiness and windbreak suitability. Drought tolerant; does well in difficult sites up to 7,000'.

* (F) **HONEYLOCUST** - Mature height 40'. Broad, open crown. Excellent cold hardiness. Potential disease problems; up to 7,500'.

* **KENTUCKY COFFEE TREE** - Mature height 60-75'. Sparse branch structure to allow sunlight into areas in winter. Cold hardy. Seedpods are potentially toxic to humans and cattle (most cultivars are male and will not produce seeds); elevation up to 7,500'.

* **MANCHURIAN APRICOT** - Mature height to 20'. Fast growing, rounded, spreading form. Excellent cold hardiness, attractive flowers, edible fruit. Valuable to bees and wildlife.

* **NORTHERN CATALPA** - Hardiness Zones 4 - 8. Spreading canopy capable of blocking sunlight. Grows in acidic, alkaline, loamy, moist, rich, sandy, silty loam, well drained, wet and clay soils.

*** **ROCKY MOUNTAIN MAPLE** - Mature height up to 30'. Native large shrub or small tree. Beautiful fall color. Well suited for songbird, game bird, small mammal and big game habitat.

EVERGREEN TREES

*** **AUSTRIAN PINE** - Mature height 40'. Densely pyramidal. Excellent drought resistance up to 7,000'. Very adaptable, establishes quickly, good windbreak tree.

* **BLACK HILLS SPRUCE** - Mature height 30-60'. Exceptionally dense foliage. Ideal for windbreaks or screens. Slow growth. Good for nesting birds and small mammal habitat.

* **BOSNIAN PINE** - Mature height up to 40'. Evergreen shade tree. Tolerant of deer, sandy or clay soils. Prefers moist cooler summer locations. Avoid poorly drained wet soils.

*** **BRISTLECONE PINE** - Mature height 30'. Distinctive appearance-picturesque. Slow growing, excellent cold hardiness, drought tolerance and windbreak suitability up to 11,000'.

COLORADO BLUE SPRUCE - Mature height 60', attractive ornamental up to 9,000'. Prefers moist soils, excellent cold hardiness.

* **DOUGLAS FIR** - Mature height 50'. Native, best from 6,000-9,000'. Excellent cold hardiness, good drought resistance.

*** **EASTERN RED CEDAR** - Mature height 20'. Densely pyramidal up to 7,500'. Excellent cold hardiness, windbreak and wildlife suitability.

* **ENGLEMANN SPRUCE** - Mature height 30'. Densely pyramidal crown, best above 8,000', excellent cold hardiness.

* **LIMBER PINE** - Mature height 35'. Excellent cold tolerance, slow growing long lived with high wildlife value, up to 11,000'.

*****LOGSPOLE PINE** - Mature height 35-70' Excellent drought resistance & cold hardiness, slow growth rate, good for high elevation.

*** **PONDEROSA PINE** - Mature height 40', open crown. Native, excellent cold and drought tolerance, windbreak & wildlife suitability. Establishes quickly up to 9000'. Grows well in all but the heaviest clay soils.

*****ROCKY MOUNTAIN JUNIPER** - Mature height 20'. Densely pyramidal, tough native up to 9000'. Excellent windbreak & wildlife suitability.

* **SCOTCH PINE** - Mature height 30'. Irregular open crown and spreading branches, up to 7000'. Good cold & drought tolerance. An introduced species.

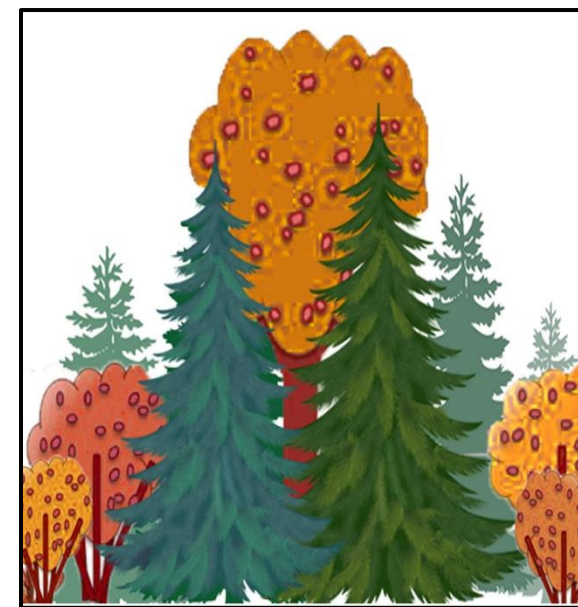
***WHITE FIR** - Mature Height 100'. Soft needle, more drought resistant substitute for Blue Spruce. Excellent cold hardiness.

* **WHITE PINE** - Hardy to USDA Zone 4 Mature height up to 80' tall, open, irregular crown, branches are long and horizontal. Pyramidal-conical shape that broadens with age.
