



**BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS  
MINUTES OF PROCEEDINGS  
March 15, 2011**

The regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners was brought to order at 5:30 p.m. by Chairman Opella. Those in attendance were Commissioners Bill McDowell, Rob Hendry via telephone, Terry Wingerter, Matt Keating, County Clerk Renea Vitto, County Attorney Bill Knight, Deputy County Attorney Heather Duncan Malone and Commissioners' Secretary Michelle Maines.

Chairman Opella presented Barbara Peryam with a plaque thanking her the years of dedicated service as a County Commissioner.

Commissioner Wingerter moved to approve the Minutes of Proceedings for March 1, 2011. The motion was seconded and carried.

Commissioner McDowell moved to approve the Special Meeting Minutes of Proceedings for February 22, 2011. The motion was seconded and carried. Commissioner Keating abstained from the vote.

Commissioner Wingerter moved to approve the payment of bills in the amount of \$875,453.05. The motion was seconded and carried.

County Clerk Renea Vitto reported the following transfer is in the amount of \$2,522,663.84 to be taken from unanticipated revenue, and distributed to the following accounts: Commissioners/Projects, Grants/Juvenile Services Grant 9243-005-34 \$55,502.84; Commissioners/Projects, Grants/Juvenile Detention Center 9254-005-34 \$2,467,161.00

Commissioner Wingerter moved to approve Resolution 11-11, Transfer of Funds. The motion was seconded and carried.

Chairman Opella opened the floor to Commissioner Comments.

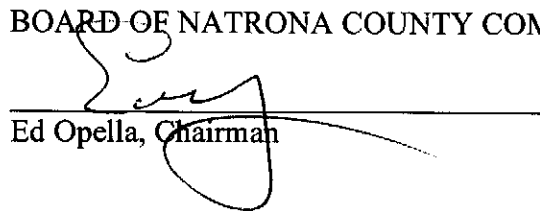
