CAMPAIGN REPORTING REQUIREMENTS
(Receipts and Expenditures)

All Candidates, Campaign Committees and Political Action Committees for County and Municipal offices must file a PRIMARY STATEMENT OF CONTRIBUTIONS AND EXPENDITURES with the County Clerk by Tuesday, August 2, 2022.

W.S.22-25-108; Any person required to file a report under W.S. 22-25-106 shall be given notice prior to an election, by the appropriate filing office specified under W.S.22-25-107, that failure to file the report within the time required by that section shall subject the person to civil penalties as provided in subsection (f) of this section. The notice shall inform any candidate’s campaign committee, organization, political party or political action committee that the officers responsible for filing the report shall be subject to the same civil penalties as the candidate’s campaign committee, organization, political party or political action committee for failure to file the report.

ASSISTANCE

If you require assistance to vote for any reason, a person of your choice may give you assistance at the polls. You may also request an absentee ballot as set forth below.

ABSENTEE BALLOTS

Absentee balloting at the County Clerk’s office will begin on Friday, July 1, 2022 with UOCAVA ballots available that same day. If you do not plan to vote at your polling place on Primary Election Day, you may either vote at the Clerk’s office, Room 154 of the County Courthouse Building, 200 North Center, or have an absentee ballot sent to you. Call 235-9217 or email elections@natronacounty-wy.gov to request an absentee ballot by mail.

VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE

The last day to register to vote in the County Clerk's office prior to Primary Election Day is Monday, August 1, 2022. Voter registration and changes in registration are permitted at your polling place on Primary Election Day.
